Hello to all Club Members and regular Whitby Motocross competitors.

This is the start of a new year and a new Motocross season. The Whitby Club will be running a four round Club Championship as usual this year but you can enter as many of the rounds as you like. As in previous years we will also be hosting some of the other organisations who are clamouring to hold their events on this amazing track. There may be room in their events for some local riders; details are available on their websites.

There are some new track features for 2010, all designed to make it even more interesting whilst building on the inherent safety of the venue. We are also adding two new classes, an over 40 class for the many experienced riders for whom 'life begins at forty' and an Evolution Class for those who own pre1990 Motocross machines and like to give them a competitive outing. Both new classes will compete in the same set of three races at each meeting and the results will be separated later. To make things even more interesting we will be paying cash awards for these new classes. Prize money is to be greatly increased in the other classes as you will see from the Event Regulations.

Some competitors may want to ride in for example the Expert or Junior Championship class and also in the Evo class so we will arrange the programme to enable this. We will be asking for an additional entry fee of just £10 to ride in two classes.

As last year you can enter all four rounds on one entry form and pay for each round separately by cheques post dated for eleven days before each event. One advantage of this approach is that you are automatically entered and there is no last minute panic to get in before the entry list fills up for each round.

As you fill in your forms don't worry if you haven't got your MCF licence through yet, just put applied for or something in the space. Licence forms are available from the MCF website or from the MCF office (see bottom of page). As long as you have a licence before the event it will be fine.

You may have noticed that the Holeshot awards, £10 for the first past the line after the first bend each race, are sponsored by individuals who are friends and benefactors of the club. If you or someone connected to you would like to sponsor a round you will get the event named on the front of the programme and a full page inside. Alternatively you could sponsor a class by providing awards for the Club Championship and have it named after you in the event programmes, Contact the club secretary for more details.
