Signing on, 8.30 am,

Practice, 10.00 am

10.00 am Order of practice is the same as for racing; All riders must complete a minimum of two laps per machine during the official practice sessions. The practice sessions will be of sufficient duration to allow for this.

5 General

Method of Start,

Drop down D bar. Riders will be brought under the starters orders by showing of a 15 -second board. A 5-second board will replace this and the gate will then drop within 5-10 seconds. In the event of an irreparable failure of the gate mechanism, the raising of the National flag will be used to start the race. Only competitors and officials will be allowed in the start area before the start of any race.

Finish of a Race,

Any rider crossing the finish line within 2 minutes of the race leader and within 2 laps of the leader will be classed as a finisher.

Results,

The provisional results of each race will be displayed at the office of the meeting as soon as possible after the end of the race. After 30 minutes that result becomes the official result and no protest(s) will be considered after this time.

RIDERS MUST NOT QUESTION THE LAP SCORERS AT ANY TIME, ALL ENQUIRIES TO BE MADE TO THE RESULTS TEAM IN THE OFFICE.

Club Championships,

The Club Championships are open to all Whitby Motocross Club members at Whitby MXC events. Points will be awarded at all Club events held at Skelder Banks this season. All races other than finals count for points. Four events will be held and the best three rounds scores will count. If any event is cancelled the remaining events will all count.

Every rider is expected to be honest and enter the class of their riding ability. If a rider is seen to be obviously above the standard of the group they have entered, the organisers reserve the right to move the rider up into the correct group, even if this means moving him/her up half-way through the meeting.

Marshals,

Marshals will be given expenses of £30 for the full day of racing, one per marshal point. Marshals are accepted on a first come, first served basis or on previous experience.

Conditions

1. There can be no overnight camping at the site
2. No entry to the site by competitors before 7.00am on the day of the event
3. **Dogs will not be allowed on the land. Persons with dogs will be told to remove them immediately.**
4. This event is being held on private land which is a working farm; you must respect the landowner's property at all times.
5. Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for all actions of their entourage and they may be told to leave the site if any person in their entourage misbehaves.
6. The Club reserves the right to cancel or abandon the Meeting or any part of the program, also to alter awards and/or amalgamate classes as they deem necessary.
